OUTDOOR ACTIVITIES DURING INCLEMENT WEATHER

The safety of staff and students is the first consideration on days of inclement weather.

The principal is responsible for deciding if students should be outside during periods of inclement weather. In making the decision, the principal should confer with teachers, especially those assigned to outside supervision. Students should be monitored carefully to ensure that they are dressed properly before going outside.

In Lord Selkirk School Division, all outdoor activities for students will be cancelled when wind chill temperatures fall below –27 degrees Celsius.
