



PRINCIPAL'S MESSAGE

To the families of our St. Andrews School students,

All St. Andrews School students will be returning to in-school learning on Monday, January 17 as directed by our provincial government.

I would like to acknowledge the work our families have done during remote learning with our students who were learning at home and thank you for staying connected with your child's classroom teacher through online Teams meetings, email, See Saw, and phone calls. I also would like to recognize our entire school staff for their planning and preparation for remote learning and for their virtual work and connections with students at home as well as the students at school this week.

As we return to in-school learning, we are moving into the "orange level" school pandemic response. We will maintain protocols such as:

- properly wearing a well-fitted mask when on the bus and indoors at school
- respecting the grade cohorts in place, at all times, including following cohort playground zones at recess time
- following school signage and adult instructions to maintain physical distancing, both in the school and at recess (physical distancing of two metres to the greatest extent possible)
- washing/sanitizing hands frequently
- staying home when symptoms of illness appear or isolating, when applicable, as per public health guidelines

Please also refer to the divisional email which was sent on Thursday morning (Jan. 13) which also contains information regarding our students' return to in-school learning next week.
